LESSON 3 KINDS OF SENTENCES

There are 4 kinds of sentences.

1. **Assertive sentence** : It is a statement to tell a fact.

It ends with a full stop (.)

Example : Riya is a good dancer.

2. **Interrogative sentence** : It asks a question about something or someone.

It ends with a question mark (?).

Example : What are you doing?

3. **Imperative sentence** : It expresses an order or a request.

It ends with a full stop (.)

Example : Open your book.

4. **Exclamatory sentence** : It expresses a strong feeling.

It ends with a exclamation mark (!).

Example: How beautiful the flower is !
