LESSON : 11 DEMONSTRATIVE PRONOUNS

Demonstrative pronouns : Demonstrative pronouns are used to point out or show the objects or people to which they refer.

Example: This is my pen.

NOTE: * 'This' and 'these' are used for people or things that are near to us.

* 'That' and 'those' are used for people or things that are far from us.

* 'This' and 'that' indicate singular nouns.

* 'These' and 'those' indicate plural nouns.

* This , that, these and those are also used as demonstrative adjectives

When they are used with nouns.

Example: This pen is mine.
