**AMAZING ANIMAL BABIES**

**Fact about animal babies:**

1. The baby harp seal drinks the creamiest milk. The harp seal's milk is about 12 times creamier than the cow's milk.
2. The world's tallest baby is the baby giraffe. It is about two metres tall – that's taller than most grown –up humans.
3. The biggest baby in thr world is the baby blue whale. It weighs about 3,000 kg- that's as much as 1,000 human babies. It grows 100kg every day for its first year.
4. Rabbits reproduce very quickly. A female rabbit can reproduce 12 babies every month. It could have about 3 million babies in just three years, if all the babies survived to reproduce.
5. The duck-billed platypus is a strange mammal. It lays eggs from which babies hatch out. These babies feed on the milk that oozes out over the fur of the mother's belly.
6. When the baby opossums born they cling over all their mother as she moves around.
7. Most whales and dolphins talk to their babies using clicks and special sounds called phonations. A baby humpback whale can hear its mother's call from up to 20 mile away, so it never gets lost.
8. A mother scorpion protects her babies for the first few days of their lives by carrying them on her back. If the mother is hungry, it will eat its young ones.
