Assignment 1

Days, Weeks and Months

Seven days together make a week. A week can be any period of seven days.

Days of the week in order are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Sunday.

After Sunday, it is Monday again!

Twelve months together make a year.

Twelve months of a year are January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August, September, October, November, December.

All months do not have the same number of days.

Think and answer the following.

- How many days are there in a week? **7 days**
- How many days begin with T? **2 days (Tuesday, Thursday)**
- How many days begin with S? **2 days (Saturday, Sunday)**
- What is the last day of the week, if the week starts on Monday? **Sunday**
- Name the day/days when you do not go to school? **Sunday**
- How many months are there in a year? **12 months**
- Name the first month of a year. **January**
- What is the last month of a year? **December**
- How many months in a half year? **6 months**
- How many weeks are there in a month? **4 weeks**
- How many days and weeks are there in a fortnight? **14 days, 2 weeks**
- Which month has the least number of days? **February**
